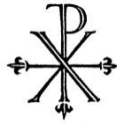

## Announcements

1. **Rosary before the Blessed Sacrament** - During the month of October, the Holy Rosary will be said before the Blessed Sacrament at 6:55pm on weekdays and Saturdays unless noted otherwise. All are welcome to come.
2. **On Sunday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, the Solemn Mass will begin at 9:30am.** There will be a Rosary procession following the Solemn Mass celebrating the External Solemnity of the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.
3. **Catechism classes** - will be canceled on Sunday, 10/6/24, due to the Rosary procession for the external solemnity of the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.
4. **Prayers** - Please keep the Humanities class in your prayers as they enter their five-day Ignation retreat to begin their seminary formation.
5. **Perpetual Adoration** - Next Monday, the 14<sup>th</sup> of October, the Perpetual Adoration of the Society of St. Pius X will be held here at the Seminary. There will be all day adoration before the Blessed Sacrament beginning after Mass and ending with Benediction in the evening. All are welcome to come.
