# Announcements

1. All Catechism classes will resume as normal Sunday, November 1<sup>st</sup> at 9 am.
2. Today, a plenary indulgence is granted to those who publicly recite the Act of Consecration of the Human Race to Jesus Christ the King.
3. From 1<sup>st</sup> Vespers on October 31<sup>st</sup> until 6:30 am the following day, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration in thanksgiving for the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the SSPX. The faithful are encouraged to join us in thanking God for His continual assistance of the Society.
4. A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful who, on All Souls Day, piously visit a church and say one Our Father and the Apostles' Creed.
5. A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed, from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 8<sup>th</sup> of November.
6. Wednesday, November 4, is the feast of St. Charles Borromeo. As he is the patron saint of seminaries and this being the anniversary of the opening of the Seminary, there will be a Sung Mass at 6:50 am.
